Lawn Maintenance Schedule

Service Season	Starting Date	General Description of Services
Early Spring	Late February	Fertilization: Balanced for spring green-up with root development and increased turf density. Weed Control: Pre-Emergent control of crabgrass and grassy weeds; broadleaf weed control as needed.
Late Spring	April	Fertilization: Balanced for color and strong growth. Inspection and Treatment: Pre-Emergent control of crabgrass and grassy weeds; broad leaf weed and insect control as needed.
Early Summer	June	Fertilization: Balanced to meet lawn and seasonal weather conditions. Inspection and Treatment: Broadleaf weed control and surface feeding insect control as needed. Inspection and Recommendation: Inspection for insect problems; cultural care and custom recommendations to enhance lawn beauty and strength.
Late Summer	July	Fertilization: Applied when conditions dictate the need for additional nutrition. Inspection and Treatment: Broadleaf weed control and surface feeding insect control as needed.
Early Fall	Mid August	Fertilization: Balanced for fall color and recovery from summer stress. Inspection and Treatment: Broadleaf weed control and surface feeding insect control as needed.
Late Fall	Late October Early November	Fertilization: Balanced for root development and winter hardiness.

Spring	February - April	Disease and Insect Control - Inspection and treatment Root Level Fertilization - for new customers with nutrient deficient plants
Summer	May - July	Disease and Insect Control - Inspection and treatment Micro-nutrient Spray Fertilization
Late Summer	August - September	Disease and Insect Control - Inspection and treatment Micro-nutrient Spray Fertilization
Late Fall	October - December	Root Level Fertilization - Preferred time to fertilize
Winter	January - February	Dormant Oil

Core Aeration	Spring April - June Fall August - November	Removal of 3/4" x 2 - 3" plugs of thatch and soil to promote air, water, and nutrient infiltration to the root zone. One of the most important turf maintenance items for a top healthy turf. Highly recommended.	(Per 1,000 Sq. Ft.)
Power Seeding	Spring March - June Fall August - October	Introduction of quality seed into the top 1/2" soil without damage to existing turf. Results are guaranteed for 2 years. Optimum results require the top inch of soil to be kept moist for 2 - 3 weeks.	(Per 1,000 Sq. Ft.)
Full Lawn Renovation	Late August to Late October	Application of Round up to kill all vegetation. Introduction of quality seed at rates high enough for coverage before winter. Starter fertilizer included in service. Requires watering by the homeowner for optimum results. Thin and bare areas touched up as lawn develops.	(Per 1,000 Sq. Ft.)
Lime	March - November	Adjustment of soil pH	(Per 1,000 Sq. Ft.)
Nutsedge	As needed	Spot treatment of nutsedge - Can expect some temporary browning of desirable turf.	(Per 1,000 Sq. Ft.)
Patch Disease	2 Applications First in April Second in May	Broadcast application of fungicide to minimize patch disease.	(Per 1,000 Sq. Ft.)
