Early Spring

• Fertilize: Balanced for spring green-up with root development and increased turf density
Weed Control: Pre-Emergent control of crabgrass and grassy weeds; broadleaf weed control as needed.

Late Spring

• Fertilize: Balanced for color and strong growth
Inspection and treatment: Preemergent control of crabgrass and grassy weeds; broadleaf weed and Insect control as needed

Summer

• Fertilize: Balanced to meet lawn and seasonal weather conditions
Inspection and Treatment: Broadleaf weed control and surface feeding
Insect control as needed.
Inspection and Recommendation: Inspection for insect problems; cultural care and custom recommendations to enhance lawn beauty and strength.

Early Fall

• Fertilize: Balanced for fall color and recovery from summer stress.
Inspection and Treatment: Broadleaf weed control and surface feeding
Insect control as needed.

Late Fall

• Fertilize: Balanced for root development and winter hardiness.

What is Aeration

Aeration is accomplished by the use of a machine equipped with cylinder like spoons designed to shatter the soil. Half-inch diameter plugs of thatch and soil are actually pulled from the ground during this process. The plunging action of the spoons into the ground opens up the soil allowing the grass plants to breathe and promoting deeper, healthier roots.

Major benefits of aeration ...

- increases air, water and nutrient movement to the root zone
- intensifies decomposition of thatch
- helps relieve soil compaction
- stimulates new growth
- improves drainage
- provides a better environment for overseeding
- increases the effectiveness of applied fertilizers and control products
- incorporates organic matter into the soil
- increases tolerance to heat and cold

What is Renovation

Renovation replaces deteriorated turf with new, improved, better adapted grasses. By seeding improved varieties into the existing lawn, the stand is improved without the inconvenience and greater cost of reestablishing a new lawn.

Advantages to Renovation

Reasonable Cost.

Minimum erosion.

Since old turf remains in place, soil erosion is minimal.
