Check Notes

Facilities:

1. Gutters & Roofs: Clean and no standing water, inspect flat roofs.
2. Water Accumulation Sites: Inspect cooling equipment, wash down areas, etc.
3. Garbage Storage Areas: Check for water accumulation, open containers, etc.
4. Screens on Windows & Doors: Keep mosquitos outside.

Adjacent Grounds:

1. Irrigation Systems: Repair leaks, avoid accumulated irrigation water that stands for more than 3 days, change practice.
2. Drainage Sites: Clean drain ways, remove materials that restrict flows, etc.
3. Open Containers: Remove unwanted tires from outside, remove buckets/containers or perforate to allow drainage.
4. Water Troughs: Flush routinely at 3 day intervals, flushed water should not collect, treat as needed with mosquito dunks.
5. Equipment: To avoid water accumulation, elevate to drain. Tarp or cover unused fish tanks.
6. Material Stock Piles: Manipulate containers and materials to avoid water accumulation.
7. Restrooms: Remove tall vegetation around restrooms, check for accumulated water nearby, move nightlights away from facility when possible.
8. Storage Facilities: Check gutters, drainage, consider excluding birds if disease outbreak occurs and visitor use is high.
9. Turf & Recreational Areas: Do not over water, maintain low surrounding vegetation, repair leaky irrigation systems.

Parking Areas and Roads:

1. Vegetation: Remove or maintain vegetation so it does not provide shade where practical-consider areas with high human traffic.
2. Roads: Fill potholes and low areas.
3. Information Signs: Post and maintain information as needed. Increase signage where outbreak occurs.
